OBC helping our community!

In conjunction with the end of year banquet, Olathe Bass Club members conducted collections for 2 incredible charities that serve Olathe and all of Johnson County, KS as well.

The **1st drive** the OBC put together was a food drive for <u>Mission Southside</u>, which provides basic necessities for low income families in Johnson County. They were in need of Back-Snack items so students would have enough food while school is not in session over the holidays.

A 2nd collection was a fund drive in support of the <u>Pennies for Shoes campaign</u>. This effort supports the <u>Olathe Mayor's</u> <u>Children's Fund</u> to make sure Olathe students in need have food, clothing, shoes and water during the holidays.

The Olathe Bass Club members shined on this night bringing in a **total of 486 food and drink items as well as \$310 in cash**. The cash donation surpassed 2023's total of \$270. All of the funds and collected items were happily delivered courtesy of the Olathe Bass Club and all of their big-hearted members.

A few weeks later, several OBC members served as volunteer Bell Ringers for <u>The Salvation Army</u> outside of Bass Pro Shops in Olathe on a couple of different nights. The funds raised by generous shoppers who donated in the red kettle make a year-round impact in the community through social services assistance, homeless shelters, disaster relief, children's programs, rehabilitation services, anti-human trafficking, and more.
