## Stockton Lake recap

The Olathe Bass Club competed in their 2nd to last tournament of the year between Sept 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> at Stockton Lake. Most anglers found the going tough with only 10 of 16 competitors bringing in a weighable bass over the 2 days of competition.

Vinnie Gay won the tournament topping 20 lbs. with 4 bass on Saturday and a limit on Sunday for his first victory of the season, moving him into the season's top 10 [for now] despite missing the first 3 tourneys of the year. Congratulations Vinnie!

Pete Morrone, who for all intents and purposes has wrapped up the Angler of the Year award, finished 2nd as he brought in a limit on Saturday and 3 more on Sunday.

Rookie Cory Herrman continued his impressive season with a 3rd place finish, and non-boater Wyatt Peterson stormed into the season's top 10 (for now) with a 4th place finish (top non-boater), including the Shoreline Boat & RV Repair Big Bass of 3.46 lbs. Tom Grandon's 3.14 lb. bass on Sunday was good for FishWear Shop / KC Elite Marketing 2nd Big Bass.

Pete's "PETA & His Chips" team won PGN Financial's Team of the Tournament with a season best 50 points, as all 6 men on his team were able to participate, bringing in the 2nd most bass. This win catapulted them into the top spot on the season 8 points ahead of Paul Marsh's "Marshmallows". Should be a good showdown for top team at next month's LOZ tournament.

The battle for Top 10 is also coming down to the wire with just 62 points separating 7<sup>th</sup> place thru 16<sup>th</sup> place, and more specifically less than 28 points separates 9<sup>th</sup> thru 15<sup>th</sup> place. A great, or poor, result at Lake of the Ozarks in October can really shake things up.
